

Amherst College James and Stearns Halls Amherst, MA

The two new, similar, four-story residence halls have an overall floor area of 62,000 SF, and house a total of 170 beds. Composite structural steel/concrete slab on deck floor construction, structural steel/steel deck roof construction. The buildings were completed in 2005 with a construction cost of \$16.5M.
